Abelia		"Petite Garden"	A small compact semi-evergreen shrub with small glossy green leaves and lilac-pink bell-shaped flowers. Height and spread 80-100cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from July to October.
Abelia	chinensis		A deciduous spreading shrub with funnel-shaped white flowers. Height 1.4m. Spread 2.5m. Well-drained soil in sun. June to September.
Abelia	engleriana		A deciduous spreading shrub with bright green leaves and funnel-shaped rose-red flowers from June to August. Height 1.8m. Well-drained soil in sun.
Abelia	floribunda		A medium sized evergreen/semi evergreen shrub with arching stems which in June are full with tubular cherry-red flowers. Height 2.5m. Spread 2m. Well-drained sheltered site in sun.
Abelia	mosanensis		A rare spring flowering Abelia, of open habit with glossy green leaves, which turn a good colour in Autumn and reddish-pink buds opening to fragrant blush white flowers. Height 2m. Spread 1-1.5m. Well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from April to May.
Abelia	schumanii		An arching deciduous shrub with slightly fragrant, funnel shaped lilac pink flowers with orange markings. Height 2m. Well-drained soil in sun. July to September.
Abelia	schumanii	"Bumble Bee"	A compact form of this deciduous shrub with slightly fragrant, relatively large, funnel shaped lilac pink flowers with orange markings. Height and spread 1.2m. Well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from July to September.
Abelia	triflora		A semi-evergreen shrub with glossy leaves and fragrant white flowers with a pink tinge. Height 2.5m. Spread 3m. Well-drained sheltered site in sun. Flowers from June to August.
Abelia	x grandiflora		A semi-evergreen shrub with glossy green leaves and fragrant white flowers tinged with pink. Height 3m. Spread 4m. Well-drained soil in sun. July to September.
Abelia	x grandiflora	"Confetti"	A small, semi-evergreen shrub with dark green, cream edged leaves that take on a pinky-red colour as the weather cools. Small, scented flared white tubular flowers. Height 60-75cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from August to Septe
Abelia	x grandiflora	"Francis Mason"	A semi-evergreen shrub with yellow foliage marked with dark green. Flowers white with a pink tinge. Height 1.4m. Spread 2m. Well-drained soil in sun. July to September.

Abelia	x grandiflora	"Gold Spot"	A semi-evergreen shrub with bright yellow foliage. Flowers white with a pink tinge. Height 1.4m. Spread 2m. Well-drained soil in sun. July to September. Considered a sport of "Francis Mason"
Abelia	x grandiflora	"Hopleys"	A semi-evergreen shrub with glossy green leaves, edged gold. Lilac-pink open bell-shaped flowers. Height 2m. Spread 2.5m. Well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from July to September.
Abelia	x grandiflora	"Kaleidoscope"	A small, compact semi-evergreen shrub with dark green leaves with gold margins. Throughout the seasons the colour changes, from intense yellow through summer to red in winter. Small, scented flared white tubular flowers. Height 60-75cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from August to September
Abelia	x grandiflora	"Panache"	A dwarf semi-evergreen shrub with sage green leaves that have a white to cream margin. Soft-pink bell-shaped flowers. Height 75cm. Spread 1m. Well-drained soil in full sun. Flowers from August to September
Abelia	x grandiflora	"Sherwoodii"	A semi-evergreen arching shrub with bright glossy green leaves, delicate pale pink flowers in summer. Height 1.5m. Spread 1.4m Well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from June to August.
Abelia	x grandiflora	"Sunrise"	Semi-evergreen shrub with soft-pink bell-shaped flowers from Aug.-Oct. The sage green leaves have a broad golden margin. Height 1.2m. Well-drained soil in full sun.
Abeliophyllum	distichum	"Roseum"	A deciduous shrub with dark green leaves turning purple in Autumn. Racemes of small fragrant rose pink tinged flowers. Height 1.4m. Spread 1.4m. Well-drained soil in sun. February to April.

Acer	circinatum		A large bushy, deciduous tree with light green leaves turning orange and red in autumn. Small purple and white pendent flowers. Height 5m. Spread 6m. Well-drained soil in sun.
Acer	griseum		"Paper-bark maple". A small deciduous spreading tree with peeling, orange-brown bark. The green leaves turn orange to red in autumn with yellow pendent flowers. Height and spread 5m. Well-drained soil in sun. This tree has been pinched back to make it bu
Acer	grosseri var. hersii		A shrubby tree with beautifully marbled bark. New shoots are red in colour. Leaves, tri lobed, turn yellow and orange in autumn. Light yellow flowers in long racemes in spring. Height after 10 years 9m. Eventual height and spread 14m.x 10m. Well-drained s
Acer	henryi		A rare spreading tree having stems marked with bluish striations. Young leaves are beautifully tinted, trifoliate, turning a brilliant red in autumn. Flowers are yellow in drooping catkins appearing with the unfolding leaves. Height after 10yrs. 5m. Moist
Acer	japonicum	"Aconitifolium"	A spreading tree with large multi-divided and deeply cut leaves turning flame red in autumn. Small hanging red flowers appear with the emerging leaves. Height 5m. Spread 6m. Moist sheltered site in sun.
Acer	japonicum	"Green Cascade"	A spreading shrub with deeply incised seven- or nine-lobed leaves of fresh green. Flowers are small pendulous corymbs, purple-red in colour. Good autumn colour, red, orange and yellow. Height 1m. Spread 2m. Moist sheltered site in sun or part shade.
Acer	japonicum	"Vitifolium"	A spreading deciduous tree with broad fan shaped leaves turning dark red in autumn and hanging small purplish flowers. . Height and spread after 10yrs. 2.5m. Moist sheltered site in sun.

Achillea		"Pomegranate"	Heads of rich pomegranate-red flowers, that do not fade with age, over grey-green filigree foliage. Height 60cm. Sunny well-drained site. Jun.-Aug.
Achillea		"Pretty Belinda"	A compact perennial with green filigree foliage and strong pink flat flowerheads. Should not need staking. Height 50cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Sept.
Achillea		"Red Velvet"	Heads of dark rosy-red flowers, that do not fade with age, over green filigree foliage. Height 60cm. Sunny well-drained site. Jun.-Aug.
Achillea		"Rose Madder"	A perennial with flat heads of soft red flowers over grey-green filigree foliage. Height 35cm. Sunny well-drained site. Jun.-Sept.
Achillea		"Saucy Seduction"	A perennial with dark green filigree foliage and bright cerise-pink flowerheads. Height 60-80cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
Achillea		"Summer Pastels"	An evergreen perennial, clump-forming with grey-green leaves. Flat flowerheads of mixed colours. Height 60cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Aug.
Achillea		"Summerwine"	Clumps of aromatic, fern-like grey-green, woolly foliage with flat flowerheads of deep wine-red. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
Achillea		"Terracotta"	Flat heads of apricot flowers fading to creamy-yellow over green filigree foliage. Height 80cm. well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
Achillea		"Walter Funcke"	A perennial with dark green filigree foliage and bright orange flat flowerheads. Height 60cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.

Achillea	millefolium	"Lachsschonheit"	A perennial with dark grey-green leaves and flat light salmon-pink flowerheads. Height 70cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.

Aconitum		"Bressingham Spire"	An erect perennial with dark green dissected, palmate leaves and spikes of deep violet blue flowers. Height 1m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sep.
Aconitum		"Ivoryine"	An upright, bushy perennial with dissected leaves. Dense spires of ivory-white flowers. Height 80cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from May to July.

Actaea	simplex	"Atropurpurea Group"	A clump-forming perennial with large, fern-like, purple-tinted leaves and arching stems of ivory white bottlebrush-like flowers. Height 60-90cm. Moist soil in part shade. Aug.-Oct.
