

<b>Echinacea</b>	"Coconut Lime"	An erect herbaceous perennial with stout stems of double daisy-like flowerheads of greenish white petals. Height 75cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept. Takes two years to perform at its best.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Fragrant Angel"	A clump forming perennial with stout, branched stems of fragrant white (with a hint of pink) flowers, held horizontally. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Green Envy"	An erect perennial with stout stems topped with broad petalled flowers that open deep green turning red from the centre as they mature. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Green Jewel"	A shortish erect perennial with stout stems topped with broad petalled green flowers with a scented green cone. Height 50cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Hot Papaya"	An erect herbaceous perennial with stout, dark stems carrying double daisy-like red flowerheads. Height 75cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Mango Meadowbrite"	A new variety with dull-green lanceolate leaves bearing branched heads of mango yellow daisies with an orange centre. Height 75cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sep.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Maui Sunshine"	An erect perennial with stout, branched stems of large flat fragrant bright yellow daisy-like flowerheads that fade to soft yellow and an orange cone. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Pixie Meadowbrite"	A new dwarf variety with dull-green lanceolate leaves bearing branched heads of pink daisies with an amber centre. Height 45cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Prima Donna Deep Rose"	A seed raised erect perennial with stout stems of large flat deep rose

		daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped golden brown disc. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Primadonna White"	A seed raised erect perennial with stout stems of large flat white daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped golden brown disc. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Raspberry Tart"	An erect perennial with stout, branched stems of large, fragrant, daisy-like flowerheads of a bright magenta colour. Height 45cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Razzamatazz"	An erect herbaceous perennial with stout stems of scented double daisy-like flowerheads of purple-pink petals. Height 75cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept. Takes two years to perform at its best.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Robert Bloom"	An erect perennial with stout stems of large flat dusky red-purple daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped golden brown disc. Height 85cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Rubinstern"	An erect herbaceous perennial with stout stems of large daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped dark orange-brown disc surrounded by stiff pink petals darkening towards the centre. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Summer Sky"	An erect perennial with stout, branched stems of large flat orange daisy-like flowerheads that fade to pink with a cone-shaped orange brown disc. Height 75cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	"Sundown"	An erect perennial with stout, branched stems of large flat fragrant russet-orange daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped golden brown disc. Height 75cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.

<b>Echinacea</b>		"Sunset"	An erect perennial with stout, branched stems of large flat fragrant orange daisy-like flowerheads with a golden brown cone. Height 75cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>		"Tangerine Dream"	An erect perennial with stout, branched stems of large, fragrant, daisy-like flowerheads of a clear orange colour. Height 75cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>		"Tiki Torch"	An erect perennial with stout stems of large daisy-like deep orange flowers with a deeper orange cone. Height 65cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>		"Tomato Soup"	An erect perennial with stout stems of large daisy-like flowerheads of a tomato-red colour. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>		"Twilight"	An erect perennial with stout stems of large daisy-like flowerheads with a unique red cone surrounded by vibrant rose-red petals with a slight scent. Height 70cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	<i>pallida</i>		A clump forming perennial with strap-like leaves and stems carrying scented daisy flowers with pink, spidery, reflexed, petals and a maroon central cone. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Echinacea</b>	<i>paradoxa</i> var. <i>paradoxa</i>		An upright perennial with narrow leaves and stems bearing yellow daisy flowers with reflexed petals and a central brownish cone. Height 70cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Echinacea</b>	<i>purpurea</i>	"Baby White Swan"	A seed raised strain with large daisy-like white flowerheads with a cone-shaped yellow-brown disc surrounded. Height 45cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	<i>purpurea</i>	"Bravado"	An erect seed raised herbaceous perennial with stout stems of large daisy-like flowerheads of deep rose-purple horizontal petals.

			Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"Bright Star"	An erect seed raised herbaceous perennial with stout stems of large daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped dark orange disc surrounded by deep purple to pale pink horizontal petals. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"Brilliant Star"	A seed raised strain with stout stems of large daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped dark orange disc surrounded by purple-red horizontal petals. Height 1.2m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"Double Decker"	An odd seed raised variety that has two sets of petals, deep rose-pink in colour. A set of short petals emerges from the cone, together with the normal reflexed ray florets. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept. May take a year to settle down.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"Jade"	A new variety of this erect perennial with a dark green cone and green flushed white flowers. Height 70cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"Kim's Knee High"	A dwarf form of this erect perennial with neat daisy flowers of rosy-pink reflexed petals and orange-brown cones. Height 55cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Oct.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"Kim's Mop Head"	An erect perennial, shorter than most forms with white daisy flowers. Height 55cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Oct.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"Lucky Star"	An erect perennial with stout stems of large daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped orange-brown disc surrounded by slightly drooping white petals. Height 75-90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"Magnus"	An erect seed raised herbaceous perennial with stout stems of large daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped dark orange disc

			surrounded by deep purple horizontal petals. Height 1.5m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"Ruby Giant"	An erect perennial with stems carrying large scented ruby-red flowers with large reddish-brown centres. Height 85cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Oct.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"Ruby Star"	An erect herbaceous perennial with stout stems of large daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped dark orange disc surrounded by stiff carmine-red petals. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinacea</b>	purpurea	"White Swan"	An erect perennial with stout stems of large daisy-like flowerheads with a cone-shaped orange-brown disc surrounded by slightly drooping white petals. Height 60cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Echinops</b>	bannaticus	"Blue Globe"	A clump-forming perennial with grey-woolly stems and grey-green leaves. Produces attractive, globe-shaped dark blue flowerheads. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Echinops</b>	ritro		A clump-forming perennial with dark green thistle-like leaves white-downy beneath. Produces attractive, globe-shaped blue flowerheads. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Echinops</b>	ritro	"Veitch's Blue"	A clump-forming perennial with dark green thistle-like leaves white-downy beneath. Produces attractive, globe-shaped dark blue flowerheads. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Echinops</b>	sphaerocephalum		A clump-forming perennial with grey-green leaves, hairy beneath. Produces attractive, globe-shaped silvery grey flowerheads on stout stems. Height 2m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Echium</b>	russicum		A bushy perennial with lanceolate leaves and flower spikes of an unusual burgundy red colour. Height 50cm. Well drained

sheltered site in sun. Jun.-Jul.

<b>Echium</b>	vulgare		A native, bristly biennial with greyish-green, hairy leaves. Dense spikes of open bell-shaped, violet-blue flowers, purple in bud. Height 60-90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Edraianthus</b>	caricinus		Clumps of narrow, grassy, leaves with lax stems terminating in a cluster of blue-violet bell flowers. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jul.
<b>Edraianthus</b>	graminifolius		A small tufted alpine with rosettes of narrow, mid-green leaves, bearing short stems of upturned bell-shaped, deep purple flowers. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Ma-Jul.
<b>Edraianthus</b>	pumilio		A cushion of narrow grass-like, silvery green leaves bears almost stemless upturned bell-shaped, pale to deep violet flowers. Height 5cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May. Protect from winter wet.
<b>Edraianthus</b>	serbicus		Prostrate stems of linear deep green leaves with clusters of violet blue campanulate flowers. Height 5-10cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun. Protect from winter wet.
<b>Edraianthus</b>	serpyllifolius		Prostrate stems of spatulate deep green leaves with solitary dark violet upturned bells. Height 5-10cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May. Protect from winter wet.
<b>Elaeagnus</b>	angustifolia	"Quicksilver"	Medium sized deciduous shrub with intense silver foliage. Highly scented creamy yellow flowers appear from May-Jul. Height 3m. Best in full sun in fertile well-drained soil.
<b>Elaeagnus</b>	pungens	"Frederici"	A dense slow growing evergreen shrub. Small narrow leaves creamy yellow with glossy, dark green margins and fragrant silvery white flowers. Height 2-3m. Well-drained soil in sun. Sep.-Apr.

<b>Elaeagnus</b>	pungens	"Hokuea Fucarini"	A new variety with leaves having a distinctive silver-cream edged variegation. Fragrant silvery-white flowers borne in autumn. Height 3m. Spread 2m. Well-drained soil in sun.
<b>Elaeagnus</b>	pungens	"Maculata"	A dense evergreen shrub with dark green leaves boldly marked dark yellow in the centres, silvery white highly fragrant flowers is followed by brown ripening to red fruit. Height 2m. Spread 2m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from September
<b>Elaeagnus</b>	x ebbingii	"Eleador"	A new variety with bright golden yellow leaves with a narrow green margin. Small silvery white flowers are borne in late summer. Height 2-3m. Spread 2m. Well drained soil in sun.
<b>Elaeagnus</b>	x ebbingii	"Gilt Edge"	A vigorous evergreen shrub with glossy, dark green leaves with golden yellow margins, silvery beneath. Creamy white flowers can be followed by orange speckled silver fruit. Height 4m. Spread 4m. Well-drained soil in sun. September to October.
<b>Elaeagnus</b>	x ebbingii	"Gold Splash"	An evergreen shrub with attractive wavy edged green leaves with a bold gold splash. Small bell shaped fragrant silvery-white flowers. Height 2m. Spread 1.6m. Well-drained soil in sun. Flowers August, October.
<b>Elaeagnus</b>	x ebbingii	"Limelight"	A vigorous shrub with silvery young leaves which become marked with yellow and pale-green in the centre, silvery underneath. Small creamy-white fragrant flowers followed sometimes by orange speckled fruit. Height and spread 3m. Well-drained soil in sun. F
<b>Embothrium</b>	coccineum	"Lanceolatum Group"	An upright evergreen tree with narrow mid green leaves. Attractive clusters of scarlet flowers. Height after 10yrs. 3-4m. Moist well-drained acidic soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from

			March to May.
<b>Enkianthus</b>	campanulatus		Deciduous bushy shrub eventually attaining 10ft. Twiggy growth with sulphur/bronze bell-shaped flowers in late spring. Leaves turn red in Autumn. Grows in sun or part shade in moist acid soil.
<b>Enkianthus</b>	campanulatus	"Red Bells"	An attractive deciduous, tree-like shrub with dull green toothed leaves, turning orange-yellow to red in autumn. Clusters of delicate, pendent bell-shaped red flowers. Height 2.5m. Moist well-drained acid soil in sun or part shade. Mar.-May.
<b>Enkianthus</b>	campanulatus	"Sikokianum"	An attractive deciduous, tree-like shrub with dull green toothed leaves, turning orange-yellow to red in autumn. From maroon buds come clusters of delicate, pendent bell-shaped dark brick-red flowers. Height 2m. Spread 2m. Moist well-drained acid soil in
<b>Enkianthus</b>	chinensis		A small tree or narrow large shrub with relatively large leaves with red petioles and flowers in umbels yellow and red with darker veins. Good autumn colour. Height up to 6m. Moist well-drained acid soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from May to July.
<b>Epilobium</b>	angustifolium	"Album"	Spires of narrow pale green leaves topped with white flowers. Height 90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Epilobium</b>	crassum		A low spreading plant with rounded waxy deep green leaves tinged red. White or pink flowers produced on the ends of longish stems. Height 10cm. Spread 30cm. Moist soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Epimedium</b>		"Akebono"	A clump-forming, herbaceous perennial with heart-shaped leaves that emerge a reddish colour, together with the white heavily flushed pink flowers. Height 25cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-May.

<b>Epimedium</b>	"Amber Queen"	A hybrid with mottled green foliage and stems of yellow flowers that turn to orange. Height 35cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr.-Jun.
<b>Epimedium</b>	"Enchantress"	A good hybrid with glossy, evergreen leaves with sprays of spidery lavender-pink flowers. Height 30cm. Moist soil in part shade. Mar.-May
<b>Epimedium</b>	"Little Shrimp"	A dwarf deciduous, spreading perennial with shrimp-pink flowers. Height 15-20cm. Moist soil in part shade. Mar.-May
<b>Epimedium</b>	"Pink Elf"	A clump-forming perennial with heart-shaped green and russet leaves. Purple-pink, spurred, flowers are held above the foliage. Height 25-40cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-May.
<b>Epimedium</b>	brachyrrhizum	A clump-forming herbaceous perennial with heart-shaped, green leaves, bronze- purple when young. Charming pendent, pale pink flowers darkening towards the centre. Height 20-30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Epimedium</b>	campanulatum	A creeping perennial with dark-green glossy semi-evergreen leaves and spurless pale yellow flowers. Height 25cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr-May.
<b>Epimedium</b>	dauidii	Soft yellow flowers from Apr.-Jun. Height 20-30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade.
<b>Epimedium</b>	epsteinii	A creeping perennial with dark-green glossy evergreen leaves and large blooms of pure white with reddish purple spurs and cups. Height 25cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Epimedium</b>	grandiflorum	A clump-forming herbaceous perennial with heart-shaped, green leaves, bronze when young. Charming relatively large pendent pink, white, purple, or yellow flowers with spurs. Height 20-

			30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Epimedium</b>	grandiflorum	"Crimson Beauty"	A clump-forming herbaceous perennial with heart-shaped, green leaves, bronze- purple when young. Charming pendent, crimson red flowers with white tipped spurs. Height 30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Epimedium</b>	grandiflorum	"Lilafee"	Rich green leaves, purple tinted when young with pendent, violet-purple flowers with spurs. Height 20-30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Epimedium</b>	grandiflorum	"Nanum"	A diminutive form with small heart-shaped leaves, with a red edge when new and short wiry stems carrying white spurred flowers. Height 15cm. Moist well-drained humus-rich soil in part shade. Apr.-Jun.
<b>Epimedium</b>	grandiflorum	"Rose Queen"	A clump-forming herbaceous perennial with heart-shaped, green leaves, bronze- purple when young. Charming pendent, rose-pink flowers with white tipped spurs. Height 20-30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Epimedium</b>	grandiflorum	"White Queen"	A clump-forming herbaceous perennial with heart-shaped, green leaves, bronze- purple when young. Charming pendent, largish white flowers. Height 30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Epimedium</b>	membranaceum		A clump-forming herbaceous perennial with heart-shaped, green leaves, mottled crimson when young. Spidery yellow flowers with reddish sepals. Height 40cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Epimedium</b>	perralderianum		Charming pendent, bright yellow flowers with short brown spurs. Height 30cm. Moist fertile soil in part shade. March to April.

<b>Epimedium</b>	pinnatum ssp. colchicum		A clump-forming perennial with charming bright yellow flowers with short brown or yellow spurs. Height 30-40cm. moist well-drained soil in part shade.
<b>Epimedium</b>	pubigerum		Evergreen clumps of shiny green leaves with stems carrying yellow and pink flowers. Height up to 50cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr.-May.
<b>Epimedium</b>	rhizomatosum		A late flowering clump forming perennial with glossy, spiny-looking, evergreen foliage. Masses of light yellow flowers darkening towards the centre. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. May-Jul.
<b>Epimedium</b>	stellulatum	"Wudang Star"	An evergreen perennial with strong upright growth, bronze when new. Arching stems carry many starry white flowers with yellow stamens. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-May.
<b>Epimedium</b>	wushanense	"Caramel"	A perennial with elegant toothed glossy green leaves sometimes mottled red. Tall stems carry spidery buff pink flowers with yellow tones. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.May.
<b>Epimedium</b>	x cantabrigiense		Nodding pinky-beige and yellow flowers in spring. Height 30-60cm. Fertile, moist well-drained soil in part shade.
<b>Epimedium</b>	x perralchicum		A clump-forming evergreen perennial with delicate deep green leaves, bronze when young and charming pendent bright yellow flowers. Height 30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-Apr. Takes drier conditions than some varieties.
<b>Epimedium</b>	x perralchicum	"Frohnleiten"	Charming pendent bright yellow flowers, with very short brown spurs. Height 40cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Epimedium</b>	x rubrum		Green leaves, flushed red when young, turning red in autumn.

			Charming crimson and pale yellow flowers with short spurs. Height 30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Mar.-Apr.

<b>Epimedium</b>	x youngianum	"Roseum"	A clump-forming perennial with bright green leaves on red tinted stems. Charming dusky pink to purple flowers. Height 20-30cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Epipactis</b>	gigantea		An orchid with spirally arranged leaves and dense spikes of pretty bright, greenish yellow, flowers with maroon veins. Height 30-40cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr.-May.
<b>Eranthis</b>	hyemalis		"Winter Aconite". A tuberous, herbaceous perennial with bright yellow flowers. Height 5-8cm. Sun or shade in moist soil. Feb.-Mar.

<b>Eranthis</b>	hyemalis	"Cilicia Group"	"Winter Aconite". A tuberous, herbaceous perennial with bronzey foliage and deep yellow flowers. Height 5-8cm. Sun or shade in moist soil. Feb.-Mar.
<b>Erigeron</b>		"Adria"	A clump-forming perennial with violet-blue semi double daisy-like flowers. Height 75cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Erigeron</b>		"Charity"	A clump-forming perennial with clear pale pink flowers with yellow centres. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Erigeron</b>		"Darkest of All"	A clump forming perennial with deep violet daisy flowers on stems 60cm. high. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Erigeron</b>		"Dignity"	A clump-forming perennial with violet-mauve, orange-centred, daisy flowerheads. Height 35cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Jul.
<b>Erigeron</b>		"Foerster's Liebling"	A clump-forming perennial with very deep rose-pink semi double daisy-like flowers. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Erigeron</b>		"Four Winds"	Spreading fans of stems carrying large pale mauve daisy flowers with yellow centres. Height 15-25cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Erigeron</b>		"Mrs. F. H. Beale"	An upright herbaceous perennial with green basal leaves and stems carrying lilac-pink flushed blue daisy flowers Height 60cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Erigeron</b>		"Nachthimmel"	A clump-forming perennial with deep purple semi-double daisy flowers on stems 60cm. high. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Erigeron</b>		"Quakeress"	A clump-forming perennial with pretty single pink flushed white, yellow-centred, daisy flowerheads. Height 60cm. Well-drained soil in sun or shade. May-Jul..

**Euonymus** oxyphyllus

A slow-growing shrub with leaves that turn rich shades of red and purple-red in autumn. Also in autumn, the branches are studded with carmine red fruit capsules. Height 3-4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade.

**Euonymus** phellomanus

A compact shrub with large dark green leaves with stems conspicuously corky-winged. Insignificant white flowers followed by attractive four-lobed pink fruits freely carried. Height 2-3m. Spread 1-2m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.

**Euonymus** planipes

A deciduous shrub with unusual long spear-shaped growth buds. The long mid-green leaves turn brilliant red in autumn with attractive four-lobed red fruits. Height 3m. Spread 3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May to June.

**Euonymus** sanguineus

A rare shrub with the young shoots and leaves often flushed purple. Red fruits and striking foliage in autumn. Height 3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade.

**Eupatorium** album

"Braunlaub"

A perennial with dark stems carrying whorls of brownish leaves topped with heads of white, beige-tinged flowers. Height 1.5m. Moist soil in sun or part shade.

**Eupatorium** fistulosum

"Atropurpureum"

A tall perennial with whorls of pointed leaves and red stems carrying flattish inflorescences of wine-red flowers. Height 2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.

**Eupatorium** purpureum

"Purple Bush"

Erect stems of coarse toothed leaves topped with fluffy purple-red flowerheads. Height 1.2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Sept.-Nov.

Upright stems of dark evergreen foliage, almost black in full sun and heads of small yellow flowers

			with pink flushed bracts on reddish stems. Height 40cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
