

<b>Fabiana</b>	imbricata		A dense, mound-forming, evergreen shrub with plume-like branches clothed with needle-like deep green leaves and tubular, white flowers,. Height 2.5m. Spread 2.5m. Well-drained sheltered site in sun. April to June.
<b>Fabiana</b>	imbricata f. violacea		An upright shrub with plume-like branches, spreading horizontally, clothed with needle-like green leaves and tubular, lavender-mauve flowers,. Height 2.5m. Flowers from April to June. Frost hardy. Well-drained sheltered site, in sun.
<b>Fagus</b>	crenata	"Mt. Fuji"	A smaller growing selection, being well branched with yellowish-green leaves. Height 3-4m. Spread 2-3m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Ansoergei"	A beautiful slow growing tree with purple, deeply cut leaves on arching stems. Very suitable for chalky soils. Eventual height 4-5m. Spread 5-6m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Asplenifolia"	The "Fern-leaf Beech". A beautiful slow growing tree with deeply cut leaves. Very suitable for chalky soils. Foliage turns golden-yellow in Autumn. Eventual height 15m. Spread 5m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Atropurpurea"	A large deciduous tree with light red leaves in spring turning dark purple. Eventual height 18m. Spread 7-10m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Black Swan"	Forms a tree with initially a strong leader which then weeps, with all the side branches weeping, giving a very narrow tree. The leaves are a dark purple-red. Height 6m. Spread 3m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Dawyck Gold"	A compact and narrow tree with wavy margined leaves, bright yellow at first, turning green, then yellow to orange-brown in autumn. Height after 10 years 8m. Eventual height and spread 25m.x 7m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Dawyck's Purple"	A compact and narrow tree with wavy margined deep purple leaves. Height after 10 years 8m. Eventual height and spread 25m.x 6m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.

<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Franken"	A selection of Beech that has white marbled, variegated leaves. The amount of variegation changes through the season and with the age of the plant. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Eventual height 3m. and spread 2m.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Greenwood"	An upright growing selection with an obovate leaf that has a lighter green margin. As the season progresses the leaf turns green and the shape reverts to normal. Height 4-5m. Spread 2m.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Luteovariegata"	A form of beech with the leaves having a yellow margin. Height 20m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Mercedes"	A dwarf selection of the narrow leaf beech. It eventually forms a small tree with deep green incised leaves that turn yellow in autumn. A useful tree for chalky soils, Height and spread after 10 yrs. 1-1.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Pendula"	An elegant deciduous weeping tree with wavy margined leaves, pale at first, turning glossy dark green, then yellow to orange-brown in autumn. Height 15m. Spread 15m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Purpurea Tricolor"	A slow growing, deciduous tree with wavy margined leaves of purple edged and striped pink and pinkish white. Height 6m. Spread 5m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Riversii"	A large deciduous tree with large, dark purple leaves. Height 18m. Spread 7-10m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Tolerant of most soil types.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Rohanii"	A beautiful deciduous large tree with deeply cut dark purple leaves. slow growing with an eventual height around 18m and spread from 7-10m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fagus</b>	sylvatica	"Striata"	A slow growing, deciduous tree with leaves striped dark and yellow green. Height 6m. Spread 5m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Fascicularia</b>	bicolor		A rosetted bromeliad with spiny toothed green leaves and pale blue flowers surrounded by white bracts. Height 45cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.

<b>Fatsia</b>	japonica		A spreading evergreen shrub with deeply lobed, dark green leaves. Round creamy white flowers on long stalks, followed by black fruit. Height 1.5-3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Sept.-Oct.
<b>Fatsia</b>	japonica	"Spider's Web"	A spreading evergreen shrub with deeply lobed, dark green leaves, irregularly variegated white. Round creamy white flowers on long stalks, followed by black fruit. Height 1.5-3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Sept.-Oct.
<b>Ficus</b>	carica	"Brown Turkey"	A deciduous shrub with handsome foliage of large deeply lobed deep green leaves. Minute petal-less flowers are contained in a hollowed-out receptacle, which enlarges to form edible fruit. Height 3m. Spread 4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun. August to Se
<b>Filipendula</b>	palmata	"Rubra"	A clump-forming perennial with fern-like cut, green leaves, white-woolly beneath, rose-red flowers become paler as they age. Height 1m. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Filipendula</b>	rubra	"Venusta"	A spreading perennial forming large clumps with plumes of deep rose-pink flowers become paler as they age. Height 2.5m. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Filipendula</b>	ulmaria	"Variegata"	A clump-forming perennial with green, strongly veined, leaves striped and marked yellow, dense plumes of creamy white flowers. Height 60-90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May- Aug.
<b>Filipendula</b>	vulgaris	"Multiplex"	A rosette-forming herbaceous perennial with fern-like, finely divided, dark green leaves and plumes of double, creamy-white flowers. Height 45cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Foeniculum</b>	vulgare		"Fennel." A fine foliage plant with light green filigree, aniseed flavoured leaves, and flat umbels of yellow flowers followed by aromatic seeds. Height 1,8m. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Foeniculum</b>	vulgare	"Purpureum"	"Fennel." A fine foliage plant with bronze-purple filigree, aniseed flavoured leaves, and flat umbels of

			yellow flowers followed by aromatic seeds. Height 1,8m. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Forsythia</b>		"Tremonia"	A distinct form with deeply toothed leaves. Produces large pale yellow flowers with the petals being serrate at the apex. Height 1.5m. Spread 2.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from March to April.
<b>Forsythia</b>	viridissima	"Bronxensis"	A spreading deciduous shrub with primrose-yellow flowers borne before the leaves. Height 30cm. Spread 90cm. Mar- Apr. Moist well-drained soil in sun or shade.
<b>Fothergilla</b>	gardenii	"Blue Mist"	Oval blue-green leaves, turning bright red, orange, and yellow in autumn. Fragrant white, bottlebrush flowers. Height 1m. Moist acid soil in sun or part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Fothergilla</b>	major		A deciduous upright shrub with glossy dark green leaves, turning brilliant red, orange, and yellow in autumn. Fragrant white, bottlebrush flowers borne before the leaves. Height 2.5m. Spread 2m. Moist well-drained acidic soil in sun or part shade. Flowers
<b>Francoa</b>		"Pink Giant"	An evergreen rosette-forming perennial with deeply lobed green leaves and spikes of pretty pink flowers with dark pink markings. Height 90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Francoa</b>	appendiculata		An evergreen rosette-forming perennial with deeply lobed green leaves and spikes of pretty pink or white flowers with dark pink markings. Height 60-90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Francoa</b>	sonchifolia		An evergreen rosette-forming perennial with deeply lobed green leaves and spikes of pretty pink flowers with dark pink markings. Height 60-90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Francoa</b>	sonchifolia	"Rogerson's Form"	An evergreen rosette-forming perennial with deeply lobed green leaves and spikes of pretty purple flowers with darker markings. Height 60-90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.

<b>Fraxinus</b>	excelsior	"Nana"	A dense, slow growing tree with dark green pinnate leaves that turn yellow in autumn. Eventual height 5m. with a spread of 3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun.
<b>Fraxinus</b>	mariesii		A slow growing ash with pinnate leaves that turn purple in autumn. Produces panicles of creamy-white flowers. Height 3-4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Flowers in June.
<b>Fraxinus</b>	pensylvanicum	"Variegatum"	A small tree with divided leaves, being green with a white edge. Height after 10 yrs. 4m. Moist soil in sun. Can be hard pruned and treated as a shrub.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	acmopetala		A bulbous perennial with narrow bluish green leaves and pendent, bell-shaped, green flowers with reddish brown marks. Height 40cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-June. Protect from winter wet.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	affinis		Upright stems of narrow grey-green leaves topped with nodding flowers of brown chequered with lime-green. Height 35-45cm. Well-drained soil with maybe a little shade. Mar.-May.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	aurea	"Golden Flag"	Lovely yellow spotted flowers in early spring. Height 10cm. Well-drained gritty soil in sun. Best in Alpine house.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	camschatcensis		A bulbous perennial with narrow light green leaves, and charming clusters of bell-shaped, dark black-purple flowers. Height 45cm. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	carica		Yellowish-green flowers on stems up to 15cm. Well-drained gritty soil in sun or part shade. Needs winter protection or Alpine house.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	davisii		Shiny green leaves and hanging broad bell flowers, dark purplish brown outside, yellowish-green tessellated with purplish brown. Height 20cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May
<b>Fritillaria</b>	elwesii		A bulbous perennial with narrow bluish green leaves and pendent, narrow bell-shaped, Dark purple flowers with a green stripe. Height 30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May. Protect from winter wet.

<b>Fritillaria</b>	imperialis	"Aurora"	A bulbous perennial with clusters of hanging bell-shaped dull orange flowers. Height 1.5m. May-Jun. Fertile well-drained soil in sun. Feed after flowering.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	imperialis	"Garland Star"	A bulbous perennial with clusters of hanging bell-shaped pale orange flowers darkening towards the petal ends. Height 1.5m. May-Jun. Fertile well-drained soil in sun. Feed after flowering.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	imperialis	"Grenadier"	A bulbous perennial with narrow light green leaves, and clusters of bell-shaped red flowers with red veining, crowned by a cluster of leafy bracts. Height 50-80cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	imperialis	"Lutea"	A bulbous perennial with clusters of bell-shaped yellow flowers, crowned by a cluster of leafy bracts. Height 1.5m. May-Jun. Fertile well-drained soil in sun. Feed after flowering.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	imperialis	"Rubra"	A bulbous perennial with narrow light green leaves, and clusters of bell-shaped rusty red flowers with red veining, crowned by a cluster of leafy bracts. Height 60-90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	imperialis	"Striped Beauty"	A bulbous perennial with whorls of narrow light green leaves, and clusters of bell-shaped pale orange flowers with carmine-orange veining. Height 60-90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	imperialis	"Sulpherino"	A bulbous perennial with whorls of narrow light green leaves, and clusters of bell-shaped soft orange flowers with yellow shading and carmine-orange veining. Height 60-90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	imperialis	"William Rex"	A bulbous perennial with clusters of hanging bell-shaped bronze-red flowers. Height 1m. May-Jun. Fertile well-drained soil in sun. Feed after flowering.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	kotschyana		Short stems with broad, glossy leaves and large green bells with varying degrees of brown chequering. Height 20cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Mar.-Apr.

<b>Fritillaria</b>	meleagris	A native bulbous perennial with narrow grey-green leaves and pendent, bell-shaped, white or pinkish purple flowers with dark purple veining. Height 30cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	michailovskii	A bulbous perennial with narrow mid green leaves, and charming pendent, bell-shaped, deep brown purple flowers with yellow petal tips. Height 10-20cm. well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	pallidiflora	A bulbous perennial with broadly narrow grey-green leaves and clusters of pendent, bell-shaped, pale creamy yellow flowers. Height 40cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-Jun.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	persica	A bulbous perennial with narrow glaucous grey-green leaves and racemes of bell-shaped, pendant brown purple flowers. Height 1.5m. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun. Feed after flowering.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	pontica	A bulbous perennial with narrow glaucous grey-green leaves and bell-shaped, pendant pale green flowers stained maroon at the base. Height 15-20cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	thunbergii	A bulbous perennial with narrow grey-green leaves on upright stems topped with clusters of nodding bell-shaped creamy white flowers veined green or red. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Apr.-May.
<b>Fritillaria</b>	uva-vulpis	Greyish-green leaves and narrow bell-shaped dark brownish purple flowers tinged yellow within. Height 30-35cm. Gritty well-drained soil in sun. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Alice Hoffman"	An upright bush with bronze-green foliage. Small, semi-double flowers with pink tubes and sepals, white corolla veined rose-pink. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sep.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Ban Jammin"	An upright bush with green foliage. Single flowers with pink sepals flushed mauve and aubergine corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.

<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Beacon Rosa"	An upright bush with dark green foliage and single flowers with rose-pink tubes and sepals, and a pink corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Bouquet"	An upright bush with green foliage and medium-sized double flowers with red tubes and sepals, and a violet corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Brutus"	An upright bush with green foliage and single flowers with rich pink tubes and sepals, rich dark purple petals ageing to reddish purple. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Drame"	An upright bush with green foliage and single flowers with scarlet tubes and sepals, and violet-purple petals. Height 1.2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Dying Embers"	An upright bush with dark green foliage, and hanging, small, single flowers with pinkish-red petals and aubergine corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept. Possibly needs winter protection.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Flash"	An upright bush with green foliage and single flowers with light magenta-red tubes and sepals, and magenta-red petals. Height 75cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Flashlight"	An upright bush with bright green foliage and single flowers with pale pink tubes and sepals tipped green, and a pale rose-purple corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Garden News"	An upright bush with green foliage. Double flowers with pink tubes and sepals and magenta-rose petals. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Genii"	An upright bush with yellow-green foliage and single flowers with cerise-pink tubes and sepals, and rich violet petals ageing to dark rose. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or

part shade. Jun.-Sept.

<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Gold Brocade"	An upright bush with gold foliage flushed and lined carmine. Single flowers with pink tubes and sepals and a purple corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Hawkshead"	A upright bush with small green foliage. Single flowers with white tubes and sepals suffused green, white petals. Height 1.2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Heidi Ann"	An upright bush with green foliage and double flowers with crimson-cerise tubes and sepals, and bright lilac petals paler at the base, veined pink. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sep.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"James Travis"	An upright deciduous bush with fresh lanceolate dark green foliage and medium double flowers with bright cardinal red tubes and sepals, and a violet blue corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Madam Cornelisson"	An upright bush with dark green foliage, and hanging semi-double flowers with rich scarlet tubes and sepals, and white petals. Height 90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sep.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Mauve Lace"	An upright deciduous bush with fresh lanceolate dark green foliage and large double flowers with bright red tubes and sepals, and a mauve corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Mrs. Popple"	An upright deciduous bush with green foliage. Single flowers with scarlet tubes and sepals and violet-purple corolla. Height 90cm. Spread 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. June- Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	"Phyllis"	An upright deciduous bush with fresh lanceolate green foliage and semi-double flowers with waxy rose tubes and sepals, and a rosy cerise corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained

soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.

<b>Fuchsia</b>		"Rufus"	An upright bush with dark green foliage, and hanging single red flowers. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sep. Possibly needs winter protection.
<b>Fuchsia</b>		"Snowcap"	An upright deciduous bush with fresh lanceolate green foliage and semi-double flowers with bright red tubes and sepals, and a pure white corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>		"Star Wars"	An upright bush with dark green foliage, and hanging single flowers with white petals and mauve-pink corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>		"Tom Thumb"	An upright bush with green foliage. Single flowers with carmine-pink tubes and sepals and mauve corolla. Height 30cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. June-Sept. Sheltered site.
<b>Fuchsia</b>		"Willy Winkie"	An upright bush with fresh green foliage and single flowers with dark red tubes and sepals, and brilliant white corolla. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	magellanica	"Alba Aureovariegata"	An erect bush with slender stems and serrated yellow edged green leaves. Slender pale pink flowers. Height 90-120cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May to October. Cut back in spring.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	magellanica	"Versicolor"	An erect bush with grey-green leaves flushed pink and white. Slender drooping flowers of red and purple. Height 90-120cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Oct.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	magellanica var. gracilis	"Aurea"	An erect bush with slender stems and serrated bright yellow leaves. Slender red flowers with purple "skirts". Height 90-120cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May to October. Cut back in spring.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	magellanica var. gracilis	"Tricolor"	Arching stems with small red and purple flowers. Height 1.2m. Green leaves edged white with pink shades.

			moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Oct.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	magellanica var. gracilis	"Variegata"	An erect bush with arching stems and bright creamy, white-edged green leaves and slender red flowers with purple "skirts". Height 90-120cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May to October. Cut back in Spring.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	magellanica var. molinae		Arching stems with slender pink-tinged white flowers. Height 90-120cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Oct.
<b>Fuchsia</b>	magellanica var.pumila		An erect bush with slender drooping flowers of red and purple. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained sheltered site in sun or part shade. May-Oct.
