Galanthus		"Desdemona"	One of the largest of the Greatorex Doubles. Each inner segment has strong green markings, the whole being surrounded by three broad, pure white petals. Height 20cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar.

Garrya	x issaquahensis	"Glasnevin Wine"	An evergreen shrub with bright green new leaves turning darker with age and purple stems. Long male catkins appear in late winter, an unusual green with wine-red bands. Height 3m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
Gaultheria		"Pearls"	A dwarf spreading evergreen shrub with stems of small, tight, obovate, deep green leaves. white bell-shaped flowers are followed in the Autumn by glistening white berries. Height 15cm. Spread 25cm. Moist well-drained acid soil in sun or part shade.
Gaultheria	cuneata		A dwarf densely branched, evergreen shrub with mid-green leaves. Racemes of white flowers, followed by white fruit. Height 30cm. Spread 1m. Flowers from May to June. Moist acid soil in part shade. Fruits from September
Gaultheria	fragrantissima		An evergreen shrub from Asia with narrow elliptic leaves and racemes of fragrant white urn-shaped flowers from the leaf axils. These are followed by bright blue berries. Height 3m. Moist well-drained acid soil in sun or part shade.

Geranium	"Expression"	A neat variety with bronzey-purple foliage and small flowers of magenta-pink with a white eye. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Jul.
Geranium	"Johnson's Blue"	Dense mats of deeply divided leaves and pretty lavender-blue flowers, flushed with reddish pink. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Sep.
Geranium	"Nimbus"	A large mound of finely dissected leaves and masses of deep lilac-pink flowers with a violet centre and veining. Height 30-45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Sep.
