Hebe	"County Park"	A low-growing, ground cover shrub with small, greyish-green spear-shaped, leaves and small spikes of violet flowers. Height 15cm. Spread 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
Hebe	"Emerald Green"	An evergreen shrub making an almost perfect mound of green leaves and spikes of white flowers. Grown mainly for foliage. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Aug.
Hebe	"Nicola's Blush"	A small hebe with glossy green pointed leaves and small panicles of white flowers shading to pink. Height and spread 1m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Protect from cold winds. May-Jun. and again in autumn if weather favourable.
Hebe	"Red Edge"	A spreading evergreen shrub with grey-green leaves, narrowly margined and veined red when young. Spikes of lilac-blue flowers fading to white in summer. Height 45cm. Spread 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from June to August.
Hebe	armstrongii	A compact shrub with arching whipcord bright yellow leaves and

			occasionally pretty small white flowers. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Jun.
Hebe	cupressoides	"Boughton Dome"	An evergreen dwarf shrub with small green leaves congested around the stems. It does not appear to flower. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from May to June.
Hebe	diosmifolia	"Celina"	A small evergreen shrub with slender dark green leaves and clusters of pale mauve flowers that fade to white. Height 20-30cm. Spread 30-45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from May to June.
Hebe	ochracea	"James Stirling"	An attractive evergreen, compact, arching, whipcord shrub with rich ochre-yellow leaves and pretty small white flowers. Height 45cm. Spread 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from May to June.
Hebe	pinguifolia	"Pagei"	A spreading shrub with leathery blue-green leaves on purple stems and small clusters of white flowers. Height 30cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Jun.
