

<b>Iberis</b>	semperflorens	"Weisser Zwerg"	A very compact evergreen subshrub with dark green leaves and clusters of white flowers. Height 15cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.
<b>Ilex</b>	aquifolium	"Argentea Marginata"	An evergreen shrub with spiny, white margined, dark green leaves. Insignificant flowers in summer producing abundant bright red berries in autumn. Height 15m. Spread 4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from May to June.
<b>Ilex</b>	aquifolium	"Ferox Argentea"	An evergreen purple stemmed shrub with cream-margined, dark green leaves covered with spines. Height 8m. Spread 4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun.
<b>Ilex</b>	aquifolium	"Handsworth New Silver"	A dense evergreen purple stemmed shrub with mid-green, spiny leaves with creamy margins. Produces bright red berries. Height 8m. Spread 4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun. May to June.
<b>Ilex</b>	crenata	"Golden Gem"	"Box-leaved Holly". A compact evergreen shrub with golden yellow leaves turning yellow-green in summer. Height 1m. Moist well-drained soil in sun.
<b>Ilex</b>	x altacieriensis	"Golden King"	An erect evergreen shrub with broad almost spineless grey-green mottled leaves with broad bright gold margins. being a female, it produces bright red fruit from autumn onwards.. Height 6m. Spread 5m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Ilex</b>	x altaclarensis	"Lawsoniana"	An erect evergreen shrub with light green leaves irregularly splashed gold. A female clone that produces bright red fruit. Height 6m. Spread 5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from May to June. Fruits from September
<b>Imperata</b>	cylindrica	"Rubra"	An attractive grass with narrow yellow-green leaves tipped with red in spring, by mid-summer the whole leaf is red. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun.
<b>Incarvillea</b>	arguta		An erect woody based perennial with divided dark green, pinnate leaves and tubular pink flowers. Height 90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul. May need winter protection from wet.
<b>Incarvillea</b>	compacta		A perennial with basal, divided dark green leaves and tubular, trumpet-shaped bright pink flowers with a yellow throat. Height 25-35cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.

<b>Incarvillea</b>	delavayi	A perennial with basal, divided dark green leaves and tubular, trumpet-shaped deep rose-pink flowers. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Incarvillea</b>	delavayi "Snowtop"	A perennial with basal, divided dark green leaves and tubular, trumpet-shaped pure white flowers. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Incarvillea</b>	mairei	An herbaceous perennial with basal, dark green wrinkled leaves, widely trumpet-shaped deep pink flowers with yellow and white inside. Height 15-50cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Incarvillea</b>	zhongdianensis	A perennial with basal, divided dark green leaves and tubular, trumpet-shaped cerise-purple flowers with a yellow throat. Height 25-35cm. moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Indigofera</b>	amblyantha	An upright deciduous shrub with pinnate leaves and racemes of shrimp-pink flowers over a long period. Height 1.5-2m. Spread 1-1.5m. Well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from June to September.
<b>Inula</b>	hookeri	A clump forming perennial with furry buds that open to yellow daisy flowers with an orange-yellow central cone. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Ipheion</b>	"Alberto Castillo"	Large white scented star-shaped flowers. Slightly glaucous strap-shaped leaves. Height 10cm. Feb.-Mar. Sunny, well-drained site
<b>Ipheion</b>	"Charlotte Bishop"	New, pink flowered form of this bulbous South American perennial. Height 10cm. Feb.-Mar. Needs sunny well- drained site, or maybe Alpine House.
<b>Ipheion</b>	"Rolf Fiedler"	A bulbous perennial with narrow strap shaped leaves and star-shaped, bright blue flowers with a white eye.. Height 10-15cm. Well-drained site in full sun. Feb.-Mar.
<b>Ipheion</b>	"Jessie"	A bulbous perennial with narrow strap shaped leaves and star-shaped, midnight blue flowers. Height 10-15cm. Well-drained site in full sun. Feb.-Mar. A seedling from "Rolf Fiedler"
<b>Ipheion</b>	dialystemon	Prostrate, narrow, glossy-green foliage and a profusion of brilliant-yellow, upward facing flowers. Height 5cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Feb.-Mar. Alpine House.

<b>Ipheion</b>	uniflorum	"Froyle Mill"	A bulbous perennial with narrow strap shaped leaves and scented, star-shaped, dusky violet flowers. Height 15-20cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jan.-Feb.
<b>Ipheion</b>	uniflorum	"Wisley Blue"	A bulbous perennial with narrow strap shaped leaves and scented, star-shaped, violet-blue flowers in spring. Height 10-15cm. Well-drained site in full sun. Feb.-Mar.
<b>Iris</b>		"Action Front"	A tall bearded iris with fans of strap shaped leaves and large flowers with rich mahogany-red falls with cream veining and a golden yellow beard and dusky brown/mauve standards. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Iris</b>		"Alida"	A small bulbous iris with sky blue standards and darker blue falls with yellow-orange flashes. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar. Plant deeper than normal bulbs.
<b>Iris</b>		"Austrian Sky"	A small bearded iris with bright sky blue standards the falls having darker markings with white flecks. Height 30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
<b>Iris</b>		"Blue Mystery"	A hardy juno hybrid with stems of strap-like leaves and pale blue flowers, with a yellow splash on the falls. Height 30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.
<b>Iris</b>		"Blue Note"	A small bulbous iris with violet-blue flowers and deep purple tips to the falls with white flashes and yellow. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar. Plant deeper than normal bulbs.
<b>Iris</b>		"Blue Sparks"	A small bearded iris with pale blue standards and falls having darker shading and an orange-yellow beard. Height 30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
<b>Iris</b>		"Bright Eyes"	A miniature dwarf bearded iris with white standards and white falls with a royal blue central blotch and yellow tones. The beard is yellow. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May.
<b>Iris</b>		"Cantab"	A small bulbous iris with cobalt blue standards and Cambridge blue falls with a central yellow blotch. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar.

<b>Iris</b>	"Captive Sun"	A small dwarf bearded iris with sword-like narrow green leaves and stems of pure white standards and white falls with a bold yellow centre and a pale blue beard. Height 25-30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.
<b>Iris</b>	"Dardanus"	A regeliocyclus hybrid with large flowers with lilac standards, netted with mauve and darker falls netted mahogany purple. Height 40-50cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr-May.
<b>Iris</b>	"Edward"	A small bulbous iris with dark blue flowers with orange markings. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar. Plant 5cm. below pot surface.
<b>Iris</b>	"Elizabeth of England"	A tall bearded iris with powder blue standards and falls. The beard is yellow. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
<b>Iris</b>	"English Cottage"	A tall bearded Iris with standards white with a hint of blue and white falls edged pale blue. The beards are a pale yellow. Height 80cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May.
<b>Iris</b>	"Extra"	A miniature dwarf bearded iris with light violet-blue standards and mid violet blue falls with a red-violet blotch. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May.
<b>Iris</b>	"Fashion Lady"	A miniature dwarf bearded iris which is a yellow "Self". Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May.
<b>Iris</b>	"Flaming Dragon"	A tall bearded iris that is a bright orange-apricot self, with a golden glow. The beard is red-orange. Height 80cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May.
<b>Iris</b>	"Foggy Dew"	A tall bearded iris with white standards overlaid by pale lilac-blue staining, fringed dull gold and white falls edged lilac blue. Height 65cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
<b>Iris</b>	"Frank Elder"	Lovely pale blue flowers with darker veining, the falls being overlaid with yellow. Height 10cm. Feb.-Mar. Sunny site in well-drained soil. Plant 15cm. deep (deeper than normal)
<b>Iris</b>	"Frost and Flame"	A tall bearded iris with fans of strap shaped leaves and large elegant white flowers with a hint of cream on the falls and a bright orange beard. Height 1.2m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade.

Iris	"George"	A histrionides x reticulata cross with plum purple standards and dark purple falls with yellow marks. Height 8cm. Well-drained soil in part shade. Jan.-Feb. Plant deeper than normal.
Iris	"Gingerbread Man"	A dwarf bearded iris with sword-like narrow green leaves and stems of deep brown flowers with purple-blue beards. Height 35cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
Iris	"Golden Frost"	An intermediate bearded iris with Bright yellow flowers. Height 50-60cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
Iris	"Gordon"	A small bulbous iris with light blue flowers tipped purple and orange marks. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar. Plant deeper than normal.
Iris	"Green Spot"	A dwarf bearded iris with waxy white flowers with yellowish-green spots and streaks on the falls. Height 25-30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.
Iris	"Grey Pearls"	A miniature dwarf bearded iris with creamy grey standards and falls with a pale yellow beard. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May.
Iris	"Harmony"	A small bulbous iris with royal blue flowers with yellow central marks on the falls. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar.
Iris	"Hocus Pocus"	A small dwarf bearded iris with sword-like narrow green leaves and stems of scented lavender-blue standards and dull copper falls with a blue beard. Height 25cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.
Iris	"Holden Clough"	A clump forming perennial with strap-like leaves and buff-yellow flowers heavily netted and veined rusty brown. Height 90cm. Moist soil in sun or shade. Jun.-Jul.
Iris	"J.S. Dijt"	A small bulbous iris with scented, reddish purple flowers and darker falls with yellow-orange flashes.. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar. Plant deeper than normal bulbs.
Iris	"Jasper Gem"	A miniature bearded iris with dirty cream standards and rusty red falls edged with yellow flecks and a yellow beard. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
Iris	"Joyce"	A small bulbous iris with deep sky blue flowers and yellow and white marks on the falls. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in

			sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar.
Iris	"Katharine Hodgkin"	Lovely pale bluish-green flowers with darker veining, the falls being overlaid with yellow. Height 10cm. Feb.-Mar. Sunny site in well-drained soil. Plant 15cm. deep (deeper than normal)	
Iris	"Knick Knack"	A miniature dwarf bearded iris with sword-like narrow green leaves and stems of white flowers with blue veining. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.	
Iris	"Lady Beatrix Stanley"	A dwarf bulbous iris with clear blue petals. There is strong white feathering on the falls. Height 10cm. Feb.-Mar. Sunny site in well-drained soil.	
Iris	"Lilli-white"	A small dwarf bearded iris with sword-like narrow green leaves and stems of pure white flowers even the beard. Height 25-30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.	
Iris	"Maya Mint"	A miniature dwarf bearded iris with white standards blushed yellow and white falls blushed greenish-blue. Yellow and white beard. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May.	
Iris	"Melon Honey"	A dwarf bearded iris with sword-like narrow green leaves and stems of soft orange, slightly ruffled flowers with a white beard. Height 30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.	
Iris	"Midas Mite"	A miniature dwarf bearded iris with light yellow standards and darker orange-yellow falls with a pale orange-yellow beard. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May.	
Iris	"New Argument"	A hardy juno hybrid with fresh green strap-like leaves and flowers of very pale violet with a large yellow blotch on the falls edged with violet. Height 30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.	
Iris	"Orange Tiger"	A standard dwarf bearded iris with deep orange standards and falls with a deeper orange beard. Height 25-40cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May.	
Iris	"Palm Spring"	A histrionides x reticulata cross with violet-blue standards and darker falls with yellow marks. Height 8cm. Well-drained soil in part shade. Feb. Plant deeper than normal.	
Iris	"Party Dress"	A wonderfully scented "Bearded Iris" with reflexed falls of soft peachy-melon, a tangerine beard and standards of soft peach.	

		The whole flower is suffused in burnished gold. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. May.
Iris	"Pauline"	A small bulbous iris with reddish purple flowers and darker falls with white flashes and yellow. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar. Plant deeper than normal bulbs.
Iris	"Pixie Flirt"	A miniature dwarf bearded iris with standards and falls having red violet stitching on a white ground and cream beard tipped red-violet. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May.
Iris	"Pixie"	A small bulbous iris with cobalt-blue flowers. The falls are darker blue with an orange-yellow flash and white marks. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar.
Iris	"Pogo"	A dwarf bearded iris with sword-like narrow green leaves and stems of chrome yellow flowers with a reddish brown thumbprint on the falls. Height 40cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.
Iris	"Purple Gem"	A small bulbous iris with pansy-violet standards and plum purple with white marks on the falls. Height 8-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Feb.-Mar.
Iris	"Rajah"	A tall bearded iris with yellow standards and dark crimson and purple falls with yellow streaking and an orange beard. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
Iris	"Raspberry Blush"	A medium bearded iris with raspberry-pink flowers suffused mauve on the falls with a rich orange beard. Height 50cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.

<b>Iris</b>	ensata	"Yezo nishiki"	Narrow leaves and stems of flat flowerheads, purple with a yellow-orange blotch on the falls. Height 90cm. Moist peaty soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Iris</b>	forrestii		Narrow bright green leaves and stems of clear yellow flowers with brown markings on the falls. Height 40cm. Grows best in moist peaty soil in sun.
<b>Iris</b>	forrestii	"Hybrids"	Stems of clear yellow or mauve flowers with brown lines on the falls in early summer. Height 40cm. Grows best in moist peaty soil in sun.
<b>Iris</b>	graminea		An iris with flat narrow bright green leaves and stems of purple-violet flowers with violet veined, white tipped falls. Height 40cm. Moist soil in sun or part shade. May-June.
<b>Iris</b>	histrioides	"Angel Tears"	Standards are a pale blue with the falls being gentian blue with yellow and white markings. Height 10cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Feb.-Mar.
<b>Iris</b>	hookeri		Formerly Iris setosa "Dwarf", an iris with slender mid-green leaves and stems of blue or purple-blue veined flowers with a basal white spot. Height 25cm. Moist peaty soil in sun. May-Jun.
<b>Iris</b>	innominata		An iris with very narrow deep green leaves and stems of bright yellow to cream and from purple to pale lavender-blue, rounded flowers. Height 15-25cm. Well-drained peaty soil in sun. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Iris</b>	japonica	"Variegata"	A pretty crested iris with fans of broad variegated leaves and stems of white flowers veined purple. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Mar.-Apr.
<b>Iris</b>	laevigata	"Snowdrift"	An aquatic iris with broad leaves and stems of white flowers Suffused blue at the base of the falls and into the standards. Height 80cm. Wet soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Iris</b>	lutescens	"Cambellii"	Sword-like leaves with relatively large purple-blue flowers on short stems. Height 10-15cm. well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-

			Jun.
<b>Iris</b>	<b>magnifica</b>		A juno iris with tall stems and strap-like leaves. Towards the top flowers emerge from the axils, lavender-blue to pale purple, suffused white and with a golden yellow flash on the falls. Height 50cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Best with protection.
<b>Iris</b>	<b>pallida</b>	"Argentea Variegata"	An iris with broad pale green leaves with silver-white stripes and stems of soft blue flowers. Height 90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May to June.
<b>Iris</b>	<b>pallida</b>	"Variegata"	An iris with broad bright green leaves and light yellow stripes, stems of soft blue flowers. Height 90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Jun.
<b>Iris</b>	<b>pumila</b>		A variable species, all dwarf but this one has violet-black falls, violet standards and a pale blue beard. Height 10-15cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-May.
<b>Iris</b>	<b>ruthenica var. nana</b>		A dwarf bearded iris with violet-blue flowers. The falls have strong white streaking and an orange beard. Height 20cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
<b>Iris</b>	<b>sanguinea</b>	"Snow Queen"	Beardless Siberean iris with white, yellow blotched flowers in summer. Sword-like foliage. Height 75cm. Moist fertile soil in full sun.
<b>Iris</b>	<b>setosa</b>		A variable iris with slender mid-green leaves and stems of blue or purple-blue veined flowers with lighter veining on the falls. Height 50cm. Moist soil in sun. May.-Jun.
<b>Iris</b>	<b>setosa var tricuspis</b>		Slender mid-green leaves and stems of purple-blue veined flowers with lighter veining on the falls. Height 50cm. Moist soil in sun. May.-Jun.
<b>Iris</b>	<b>sibirica</b>		Vigorous clumps of bushy leaves and tall stems carrying flowers of blue, white, yellow and pink shades flowers with veining on the falls. Height 60-120cm. Moist soil in sun. Jun.-July.
<b>Iris</b>	<b>sibirica</b>	"Blaue Wiesemotte"	Clumps of bushy sword-like leaves. Flowers have dark blue-purple falls with lighter feathering, the standards being white and blue. Height 1m. Moist soil in sun. May-Jun.
