

Kirengeshoma	<i>palmata</i>		A clump-forming perennial with pale green leaves and pretty tubular pale yellow flowers. Height 60-120cm. Well-drained soil in part shade. Aug.-Sep.
Knautia	<i>macedonica</i>		A clump-forming perennial with basal green leaves and purple-red pincushion flowerheads. Height 60-80cm, Jul.-Sep. Well-drained soil in sun.
Knautia	<i>macedonica</i>	"Mars Midget"	A clump-forming perennial with basal green leaves and purple-red pincushion flowerheads. Height 30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sep.
Knautia	<i>macedonica</i>	"Melton Pastels"	A clump-forming perennial with basal grey-green leaves and pincushion flowerheads in shades of red,pink,purple or blue. Height 1.2m, Jul.-Sep. Well-drained soil in sun.
Knautia	<i>macedonica</i>	"Thunder & Lightning"	A clump-forming perennial with basal grey-green leaves with a cream edge and crimson pincushion flowerheads. Height 60cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sep.
Kniphofia		"Bees Lemon"	Lemon-yellow flowers in dense heads on spikes 85cm. high. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sep.
Kniphofia		"Border Ballet"	A seed raised strain, vigorous with sword-like foliage and strong stems topped with dumpy pokers in a variety of colours. Height 1.5m. moist well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Jul.
Kniphofia		"Brimstone"	Slender green and yellow pokers above clumps of grassy foliage. Height 75cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Nov.
Kniphofia		"Dingaen"	A clump forming upright perennial with strap-like bright green leaves and tall stout heads of pale bronzed-yellow flowers from bronzed-green buds. Height 1-2m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sep.
Kniphofia		"Dorset Sentry"	A clump forming upright perennial with strap-like leaves and spikes of acid yellow flowers. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sep.
Kniphofia		"Drummore Apricot"	A clump forming upright perennial with strap-like bright green leaves and bronzed stems hold apricot pokers opening from green buds. Height 75-90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sep.
Kniphofia		"Flamenco"	A seed raised perennial with clumps of grassy foliage and flower spikes in shades of red, yellow or orange. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Sept.

Kniphofia	"Green Jade"	A clump-forming perennial with grass-like, arching leaves and flower spikes of green buds opening greenish white. Height 1.2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Oct.
Kniphofia	"Jenny Bloom"	A clump forming perennial with grassy foliage and slender coral-pink flower spikes that fade to cream. Height 70cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Aug.-Sept.
Kniphofia	"John Benary"	A clump forming perennial with grassy foliage and good red-coral flower spikes. Height 75cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Aug.-Sept.
Kniphofia	"Light of the World"	A clump forming perennial with grassy foliage and slender pokers of pale orange. Height 60cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Aug.-Sept.
Kniphofia	"Little Maid"	Spikes of buff-tinted, pale yellow flowers over narrow grass-like, arching leaves. Height 50cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Aug.-Sep.
Kniphofia	"Mermaiden"	A clump forming upright perennial with grass-like leaves and fat, often branched spikes of pale yellow-green flowers from green buds. Height 80cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Oct.
Kniphofia	"Nancy's Red"	A clump forming upright perennial with thin grass-like leaves and slender spikes of deep coral-red flowers. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Oct.
Kniphofia	"Newest English Hybrids"	A seed raised strain with pastel flowers in dense heads on spikes 85cm. high. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sep.
Kniphofia	"Royal Castle"	A clump-forming perennial with grass-like, arching leaves and flower spikes of red to orange buds opening yellow. Height 1m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Oct.
Kniphofia	"Samuel's Sensation"	Long narrow spikes of cream flowers open from coral-orange buds. Height 1.1m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Sep.
Kniphofia	"Sherbet Lemon"	A clump-forming perennial with grass-like, arching leaves and bright yellow flowers in dense heads on spikes 60cm. high. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sep.

Kniphofia		"Tawny King"	A clump-forming perennial with narrow grass-like, arching leaves and flower spikes of tawny apricot buds opening creamy-yellow. Height 1.2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Oct.
Kniphofia		"Tetbury Torch"	A clump-forming perennial with narrow grass-like, arching leaves and flower spikes of bright apricot yellow. Height 90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers twice between Jun.-Oct.
Kniphofia		"Timothy"	Spikes of soft salmon-peach lined with darker salmon edges and fading to cream. Height 70cm. Well-drained soil in full sun. Jul.-Oct.
Kniphofia		"Toffee Nosed"	A clump-forming perennial with grass-like, arching leaves and flower spikes of tawny orange flowers fading to creamy-yellow. Height 1m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Oct.
Kniphofia		"Wol's Red Seedling"	A clump forming perennial with grassy foliage and slender red pokers. Height 60cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
Kniphofia		"Wrexham Buttercup"	A vigorous variety with dumpy spikes of clear yellow flowers from green buds. Height 1.2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Aug.-Oct.
Kniphofia	caulescens	"Coral Breakers"	A clump-forming evergreen perennial with arching glaucous leaves and short spikes of coral-red flowers fading to pale yellow. Height 65cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Jul.
Kniphofia	caulescens	"John May"	A clump-forming evergreen perennial with arching glaucous leaves and short spikes of pink-brown buds opening to coral-red flowers fading to pale yellow. Height 60cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Sep.-Nov.
Kniphofia	galpinii		Spikes of orange-red flowers from Jun.-Oct. Height 90cm. Full sun in well-drained soil. Needs winter protection.
Kniphofia	hirsuta	"Traffic Lights"	A dwarf variety with tightly packed, arching strap-like leaves and heads of narrow pokers showing the colours of traffic lights! Height 40cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Oct.
Kniphofia	northiae		A species with enormous strap-like leaves and spikes of stumpy coral and beige pokers. Height 1.3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Aug. Needs space!

Kniphofia	ritualis	An evergreen species with clumps of broad sword-like leaves and stems topped with orange red pokers that open a greenish yellow. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Aug..
Kniphofia	triangularis	A small species with grass-like foliage and spikes of coral-orange flowers. Height 40cm. Moist well-drained sheltered site in full sun. Jul.-Oct.
