Salix	nakamura var. yezoalpina		A prostrate gnarled deciduous shrub with upright yellow catkins on olive green stems. Height 25cm. Spread 1m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade.

scented white flowers, followed by glossy black fruit. Height and spread 2.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from May to June.

Sambucus	racemosa	"Sutherland Gold"	A bushy shrub with finely cut leaves, bronze when young, turning golden yellow. Creamy yellow flowers in spring, followed by glossy red fruit in summer. Resistant to scorching in bright sunlight. Height 3m. Spread 3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or par
