Thermopsis	chinensis		A spreading perennial with attractive glaucous leaves. Upright spikes of pea-like yellow flowers on blackish stems. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.

			yellow flowers on blackish stems. Height 70cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul..

Thymus	pulegioides	"Archers Gold"	A bushy, evergreen subshrub with green and gold leaves and pretty mauve-pink flowers. Height 10cm. Spread 20cm. Well-drained site in full sun. May to July.
Thymus	pulegioides	"Foxley"	Aromatic, mid-green leaves splashed white. Pink to purple flowers. Height 15-20cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
Thymus	serpyllum	"Coccineus"	Narrow very dark green leaves. Whorls of crimson-pink flowers. Height 5cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jul.
Thymus	serpyllum	"Goldstream"	A mat-forming alpine with trailing stems of intensely variegated gold and dark green leaves and whorls of mauve flowers. Height 10-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
Thymus	vulgaris	"Silver Posie"	A bushy subshrub alpine with grey-green leaves variegated white and clusters of small pale lilac-pink flowers. Height 20-30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jul.
Tiarella		"Iron Butterfly"	Clump forming evergreen perennial with palmate leaves

and matching dark markings in the centre of the leaf. Short spikes carrying beige flowers. Height 25cm. Any soil moist or dry. Apr.-Jun.

Tiarella		"Jeepers Creepers"	A spreading evergreen perennial with heavily marked foliage and large foamy cream flowers. Height 40cm. Most soils in sun or shade.
Tiarella		"Pink Bouquet"	Chocolate blotches on large palmate leaves. Spikes of soft pink flowers, Apr.-Jun. Height 30cm. Most soils including dry shade.
Tiarella		"Spring Symphony"	Lovely cut foliage with a dark streak down the centre. Excellent spikes of pink foamy flowers. Height 25cm. Most soils in sun or shade. Apr.-Jul.
Townsendia	alpigena		Tufts of narrow greyish-green leaves and almost sessile lilac-pink daisy flowers. Height 5-10cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Needs winter protection.
Townsendia	leptotes		Mounds of small greyish leaves topped with short stemmed white daisy flowers. Height 10-15cm. Very sharply drained soil in sun or the Alpine House. Apr-May.
Townsendia	montana		Tufts of leathery, dark grey-green spatulate leaves with almost stemless bright purple daisy flowers. Height 8cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Best in cold greenhouse over winter. May-Jun.
Townsendia	parryi		Mounds of green thin, linear leaves and relatively large daisy flowers, usually lavender. Height 15cm. Gritty well-drained soil in sun or Alpine House.
Townsendia	rothrockii		Mounds of green linear leaves and substantial flowers of lilac-blue. Height 10cm. Very sharply drained soil in sun or the Alpine House.

Townsendia	spathulata		Small rosettes of silvery spathulate leaves and almost stemless pink daisies. Height 10cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Protect from winter wet.
Trachelospermum	asiaticum		An evergreen twining climber with glossy dark green leaves and fragrant, creamy white flowers. Height 6m. Well-drained soil in sun. Flowers from July to August. Shelter from cold drying winds.
Trachelospermum	asiaticum	"Golden Memories"	An evergreen twining, climbing shrub with wonderful bright golden glossy foliage and white scented tubular flowers with a gold throat. Height 6m. Well-drained site in sun. South or west-facing wall. Flowers from June to July.
Trachelospermum	asiaticum	"Theta"	An evergreen self-clinging climber with narrow willow-like leaves with silver veins. and eventually, small creamy-white very fragrant flowers. Height 3m. Well-drained sheltered site in sun. Flowers from July to August
Trachelospermum	jasminoides		A twining climber with glossy dark green leaves, turning bronze-red in winter. Small, but very fragrant pure white flowers. Height 9m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from July to August. Protect from cold winds.
Trachelospermum	jasminoides	"Variegatum"	A twining evergreen climber with glossy dark green leaves, margined and splashed with cream, often turning crimson in winter. Pure white flowers from mid to late summer. Height 4-8m. Well-drained sheltered site in sun or part shade.
Trachelospermum	jasminoides	"Water Wheel"	An evergreen self-clinging climber with narrow willow-like leaves with silver veins. small white very fragrant flowers. Height 7m. Well-drained sheltered site in sun or part

			shade.. Flowers from July to August
Trachelospermum	jasminoides	"Wilsonii"	A twining evergreen climber with rounded and narrow, glossy dark green, veined leaves, turning bronze-red in winter and pure white scented flowers. Height 9m. Well-drained sheltered site in sun or part shade.. Flowers from July to August
Trachycarpus	fortunei		Chusan Palm. A single-stemmed palm with large fan-shaped dark green leaves. Small yellow flowers emerge close to the leaf bases in early summer. The hardiest palm in Britain. Height 20m. Spread 2.5m. Shelter from cold drying winds.

Tricyrtis	hirta	"Taiwan Atrianne"	An erect perennial with hairy pale green leaves. Funnel-shaped, blue-purple spotted, white flowers held in the leaf axils. Height 80cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Aug.-Oct.
Tricyrtis	latifolia	"Yellow Sunrise"	An erect, herbaceous perennial with brown spotted shiny green leaves and pale yellow flowers with brown spotting. Height 40cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Jun.-Aug.
Trifolium	rubens		Silvery-green hairy, three-lobed leaves and short spikes of bottlebrush antique-red flowers. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
Trifolium	rubens	"Red Feathers"	Deep green three-lobed leaves and silvery buds opening to crimson-red bottlebrush flowers. Height 35cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
Trifolium	x nanum		Possibly a hybrid between T. nanum and T. dasyphyllum, it forms dense mats of erect trifoliate foliage and solitary violet flowers laying prostrate

		around the plant. Height 5-10cm. Spread 30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jun.
Trillium	albidum	Plain green leaves, sometimes faintly marbled, with upright facing, scented white flowers, often rose tinted. Height 45cm. Moist peaty soil in shade. Apr.-May.
Trillium	catesbyi	Stems carry whorls of three green narrow ovate leaves from which hang reflexed petalled flowers of pale pink or darker. Height 20cm. Moist well-drained peaty soil in part shade. Apr.-May
Trillium	cuneatum	Fragrant dark maroon upright facing flowers in spring. Height 30-60cm. Shady spot in moist, well-drained peaty soil.
Trillium	erectum	A choice perennial with handsome mid-green leaves. Three petalled dark mahogany-red flowers. Height 30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr.-May.
Trillium	erectum f. albiflorum	A choice perennial with handsome mid-green leaves. Three petalled white flowers. Height 50cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr.-May.
Trillium	flexipes	A perennial with large fresh green leaves. Pure white flowers with pink ovaries.. Height 40cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr.-May.
Trillium	flexipes x erectum	A hybrid with the large leaves of T. flexipes combined with the colour range of T. erectum. Colour can vary through pinks maroons and whites. Height 30cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr.-May.
Trillium	grandiflorum	A perennial with dark green leaves. Pure white flowers fading to pink in spring. Height 40cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr.-May.

Trillium	recurvatum		A perennial with mottled green leaves. Stemless, erect, purple flowers with recurved sepals. Height 25cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr.-May.
Trillium	rugelii		Angular green leaves with nodding white flowers with reflexed petals and a maroon centre. Height 50cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. Apr.-May.
Trillium	simile		Large unmarked leaves with large white flowers with a violet centre. Height 45-60cm. Moist peaty soil in shade. Apr.-May.
Trillium	sulcatum		A larger species with deep green veined leaves and deep red flowers with reflexed petals held upright. Height 45cm. Moist peaty soil in shade.
Trillium	vaseyi		A larger species with deep green veined leaves and deep red, scented flowers with reflexed petals held upright. Height 45-60cm. Moist peaty soil in shade.
Trollius	acaulis		A clump-forming alpine with tiny tufts of divided leaves and rounded golden yellow buttercup-like flowers. Height 10cm. Moist soil in sun. Apr.-May.
Trollius	chinensis	"Golden Queen"	A clump-forming herbaceous perennial with open, deep yellow flowers with a central

			tuft of rich orange. Height 90cm. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Aug.
Trollius	chinensis	"Imperial Orange"	A clump-forming herbaceous perennial with open, orange flowers with a central tuft of rich orange. Height 90cm. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Aug.
Trollius	europaeus		A clump-forming perennial with deeply divided leaves and lemon-yellow flowers. Height 80cm. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Aug.
Trollius	hondoensis		Deeply-lobed, shining green, chartaceous (thin) leaves, with very large, golden flowers with protruding, yellow, petal-like stamens, followed by knobby, spiked seed capsules. Height 30-45cm. Moist soil in sun or part shade.
Trollius	pumilus		Small clumps of round palmately divided leaves and short stems of upward facing five-petalled bright yellow flowers with prominent stamens. Height 15-25cm. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
Trollius	x cultorum	"Alabaster"	A clump-forming perennial with glossy deeply divided leaves and globe flowers of a pale lemon-yellow. Height 60cm. Moist soil in sun or shade. May-Jun.
Trollius	x cultorum	"Cheddar"	A clump-forming perennial with glossy deeply divided leaves and flowers that start yellow but pale to lemon-yellow. Height 60cm. Moist soil in sun or shade. May-Jun.

Tulipa		"Berlioz"	Maroon mottled greyish leaves and yellow flowers flushed red with an attractive red and yellow centre. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Mar.-Apr.
Tulipa		"Fur Elise"	Attractive mottled leaves and flowers of amber yellow, suffused apricot pink. Height 20cm. Well-drained soil in sun. April
Tulipa	batalinii	"Salmon Gem"	Narrow grey-green leaves and deep salmon flowers paler on the backs of the outer petals. Height 15cm. Sunny well-drained spot. Apr.-May.
Tulipa	biflorifomis		Dark linear lanceolate leaves in pairs with multi-headed flowers, white with brownish-violet outside. Height 15-20cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Mar.-Apr.
Tulipa	cretica		A miniature species with narrow dark green leaves and multi headed flowers, white with a pink flush to the outside of the petals. Height 10cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Apr.
Tulipa	dasytemon		Broadish greyish-green leaves and starry yellow flowers with a bronze reverse. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. April.
Tulipa	hageri	"Tiny Timo"	Narrow grey green leaves and crimson-red flowers with a pale blue centre edged white. Height 10-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. April.
Tulipa	heweri		A multi flowered variety with yellow flowers flushed red. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. April.

Tulipa	humilis	"China Coral"	A variety with violet-pink flowers and a yellow base on stems 10-15cm. high. Sunny spot in well-drained soil. Mar-Apr.
Tulipa	humilis	"Eastern Star"	Magenta flowers on 10cm. stems during May. Sunny well-drained site.
Tulipa	humilis	"Lilliput"	Multi-headed red flowers with a dark base on stems 10cm. high from Mar-Apr. Sunny spot in well-drained soil.
Tulipa	humilis	"Magenta Queen"	A dwarf tulip with lilac-purple flowers flamed green. Height 10-15cm. Sunny spot in well-drained soil. Mar.-Apr.
Tulipa	humilis	"Odalisque"	Beetroot purple flowers with a yellow base on stems 10cm. high from Mar-Apr. Sunny spot in well-drained soil.
Tulipa	humilis	"Persian Pearl"	A dwarf tulip with cerise pink flowers with a yellow base. Height 10cm. Sunny spot in well-drained soil. Mar.-Apr.
Tulipa	humilis	"Tete a Tete"	A variety with double pinkish red flowers. Height 10-15cm. Sunny spot in well-drained soil. Mar-Apr.
Tulipa	humilis	"Violacaea"	Magenta pink flowers with a black base on stems 10cm. high from Mar-Apr. Sunny spot in well-drained soil.
Tulipa	humilis	"Violacea Yellow Base"	Magenta pink flowers with a yellow base on stems 10cm. high from Mar-Apr. Sunny spot in well-drained soil.
Tulipa	humilis var. pulchella	"Albocaerulea Occulata"	A rare dwarf tulip. Height 10cm. White with a steel blue base. Flowers Mar-Apr. Well-drained soil in full sun.
Tulipa	humilis var. pulchella	"Rosea Caerulea Occulata"	A rare dwarf tulip. Height 10cm. White flushed pink with a steel blue base. Flowers Mar-Apr. Well-drained soil in full sun.
Tulipa	iliensis		A small tulip with narrow glaucous leaves and lemon yellow flowers with a violet-crimson blush to the outer petals. Height 15-20cm. Well-drained soil in sun. March.

Tulipa	kolpakowskiana	Bright yellow flowers with carmine red shading on the outer petals. Height 10-20cm. Well-drained soil in sun. April.
Tulipa	linifolia	Glossy scarlet flowers with a blackish purple base. Height 10-15cm. Well-drained soil in full sun. Mar.-Apr.
Tulipa	polychroma	Multi headed tulip with white flowers, faintly tinged pink and a yellow centre. Grow in full sun in well-drained soil. Feb.-Mar. Height 10-15cm.
Tulipa	schrenkii	A dwarf tulip with glaucous wavy-edged leaves and red flowers maybe with a yellow edge. Height 10cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Mar.-May.
Tulipa	sogdiana	A small tulip with narrow leaves and multi headed white flowers with a yellow base. Height 10-15cm. Well-drained soil in sun.
Tulipa	sprengeri	A late flowering species with narrow leaves and brilliant scarlet flowers. Height 30-40cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May-Jun.
Tulipa	sylvestris	Flowers hang sideways, deep yellow, reflexed at the tips and slightly scented. Thinner foliage than most tulips. Height 20-30cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Mar.-May.
Tulipa	wilsoniana	Deep red flowers on stems 15cm. high during Apr.-May. Sunny spot in well-drained soil.
