| <b>Ulmus</b>    | parvifolia                  | "Hokkaido"  | A dwarf form of the Chinese Elm. Tiny deciduous green leaves on a plant 30cm. high. Well-drained soil in a site protected from wind.   |
| <b>Uncinia</b>  | rubra                       |             | An evergreen perennial with reddish brown leaves and narrow spikes of brown to black flowers. Height 20-30cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Aug.                              |
| <b>Uncinia</b>  | rubra                       | "Everflame" | An evergreen perennial with reddish brown leaves having a cherry-red margin and narrow spikes of brown to black flowers. Height 20-30cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Aug.   |
| <b>Uvularia</b> | grandiflora                 |             | A choice perennial with pendent yellow flowers, sometimes flushed green. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. May-Jun.  |
| <b>Uvularia</b> | grandiflora<br>var. pallida |             | A choice herbaceous perennial with downward pointing mid-green leaves. Pendent sulphur-yellow flowers sometimes flushed green. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. May-Jun.        |
| <b>Uvularia</b> | pubida                      |             | A choice herbaceous perennial with shiny mid-green leaves. Pendent pale yellow flowers flushed green, sometimes with recurved petals. Height 40cm. Moist well-drained soil in part shade. May-Jun. |
