

<b>Vaccinium</b>	cylindraceum	"Wide Leaf Form"	A semi-evergreen shrub with broad finely toothed, polished green leaves and hanging cylindrical flowers in short racemes, red in bud opening pale yellow green tinged red. Produces edible blue-black bloomy berries. Height 1.5m Moist well-drained acid soil
<b>Vaccinium</b>	glauco-album		An evergreen shrub with large oval leaves grey-green above, blue-white below. Cylindrical pale-pink flowers amongst rosy, silvery white bracts during May and June. Moist well-drained lime-free soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Vaccinium</b>	vitis-ideae	Koralle Group	Dwarf evergreen shrub. Pink flushed white flowers, followed by edible red berries. Height 25cm. Moist well-drained acid soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from May to August.
<b>Verbascum</b>		"Cherry Helen"	A perennial with greyish-green leaves and erect spikes of saucer-shaped cherry-red flowers with hints of apricot-pink. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun-Sep.
<b>Verbascum</b>		"Cotswold Beauty"	Spikes of coppery-orange flowers with purple centres. Height 120cm. Full sun in well-drained soil. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Verbascum</b>		"Gainsborough"	A semi-evergreen perennial with rosettes of grey-green wrinkled leaves and erect spikes of saucer-shaped, soft yellow flowers. Height 1.2m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Verbascum</b>		"Helen Johnson"	A semi-evergreen perennial with grey basal leaves and erect spikes of saucer-shaped light pinkish brown flowers. Height 90cm. Jun-Sep. Sun in well-drained soil.
<b>Verbascum</b>		"Jackie"	Broad spikes of apricot flowers with a darker eye over grey-green leaves. Height 55cm. Full sun in well-drained soil. May-Sep.
<b>Verbascum</b>		"Jester"	A perennial with greyish-green leaves and erect spikes of saucer-shaped bicoloured flowers peachy-red and apricot-pink. Height 70cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun-Sep.

<b>Verbascum</b>	"June Johnson"	Rosettes of veined deep green leaves and spikes of brownish-pink flowers with a purple eye. Height 70-90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Sept.
<b>Verbascum</b>	"Kynaston"	A perennial with rosettes of grey hairy, mid-green leaves. Erect stems, much branched of saucer-shaped white flowers with a mauve eye. Height 2m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Verbascum</b>	"Letitia"	A dense evergreen subshrub with short stems of flat clear yellow flowers with a reddish purple eye in summer. Height 25cm. Well-drained soil in sun.
<b>Verbascum</b>	"Megan's Mauve"	Rosettes of felted grey leaves and spikes of mauve flowers. Height 1.2m. Prefers a sunny well-drained spot but will take some shade. Jun.-Sep.
<b>Verbascum</b>	"Merlin"	A new variety of perennial with grey basal leaves and erect spikes of saucer-shaped pale purple flowers. Height 100cm. Jun-Sep. Well-drained soil in sun.
<b>Verbascum</b>	"Mont Blanc"	A semi-evergreen perennial with rosettes of grey-green hairy leaves and erect spikes of saucer-shaped, white flowers. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Verbascum</b>	"Plum Smokey"	A new dwarf variety with many short spikes of clear plum flowers. Height 45cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Aug.
<b>Verbascum</b>	"Royal Highland"	Perennial with spikes of apricot flowers up to 1.5m. from Jun-Oct. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Verbascum</b>	"Sugar Plum"	A new dwarf variety with lovely crinkled deep green leaves and many short spikes of clear plum flowers. Height 45cm. Well-drained soil in sun.
<b>Verbascum</b>	"Sunset Strain"	A rosette of mid-green leaves and spikes of lilac-pink flowers. Height 55cm. Well-drained soil in full sun. Jun.-Sept.
<b>Verbascum</b>	blattaria	A perennial or possibly biennial with rosettes of dark green dentate leaves. Produces erect stems of

			yellow flowers with purple stamens. Height 1.8m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Verbascum</b>	chaixii		A semi-evergreen perennial with rosettes of grey haired, mid-green leaves. Erect stems of saucer-shaped pale yellow flowers with a purple eye. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Verbascum</b>	chaixii	"Album"	A semi-evergreen perennial with rosettes of grey hairy, mid-green leaves. Erect stems of saucer-shaped white flowers with a mauve eye from mid to late summer. Height 90cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Verbascum</b>	chaixii	"Sixteen Candles"	From rough, hairy, dull green leaves arise much branched candelabras consisting of many yellow flowers with violet centres. Height 1m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Verbascum</b>	chaixii x	"Cotswold Queen"	A semi-evergreen perennial with grey-green wrinkled leaves. Erect spikes of saucer-shaped yellow flowers with a purple eye. Height 1.2m. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Verbena</b>		"Claret"	A spreading mat of dark green feathery foliage with clusters of claret-red flowers. Height 30cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Needs winter protection.
<b>Verbena</b>	bonariensis		A tall erect perennial with narrow, toothed green leaves and pretty clusters of lilac-purple flowers. Height 1.2m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sep.
<b>Verbena</b>	bonariensis	"Lollipop"	An erect perennial with narrow, toothed green leaves and pretty clusters of lilac-purple flowers. Height 60cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sep. A dwarf version of the parent.
<b>Verbena</b>	rigida		An erect to spreading perennial with fragrant clusters of bright purple or magenta-pink flowers in summer. Height 45-60cm. Moist well-drained sheltered site in sun. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Verbesina</b>	helianthoides		Thin strap-shaped dull green leaves and large ragged yellow daisy

<b>Veronica</b>	fasciculata		flowers. Height 55cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug. A perennial with sturdy dark stems with deep green lanceolate leaves topped with multi-flowered heads of reddish-purple double daisy-like flowers. Height 1.2-1.8m. Moist well drained soil in sun or part shade. Aug.-Sep.
<b>Veronica</b>		"Fairytale"	An upright perennial with lanceolate silver-green leaves and spikes of pale pink flowers with protruding deep pink stamens. Height 40cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Veronica</b>	austriaca	"Ionian Skies"	A low mound-forming perennial with glossy dark green leaves and spikes of mid-blue flowers. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Veronica</b>	austriaca ssp. teucrium	"Kapitan"	A perennial with mid-green, serrated, lanceolate leaves and erect stems of bright violet-blue flowers. Height 10cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Veronica</b>	austriaca ssp. teucrium	"Royal Blue"	A perennial with mid-green, serrated, lanceolate leaves and erect stems of deep blue flowers. Height 25-35cm. Well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Aug.
<b>Veronica</b>	gentianoides		A mat-forming perennial with rosettes of dark green leaves. Upright stems of pale blue flowers in early summer. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun-Jul.
<b>Veronica</b>	gentianoides	"Robusta"	A mat-forming perennial with rosettes of dark green leaves. Upright stems of light blue flowers. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun-Jul.
<b>Veronica</b>	gentianoides	"Tissington White"	A mat-forming perennial with rosettes of dark green leaves. Upright stems of white flowers with a hint of blue from dark buds. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun-Jul.
<b>Veronica</b>	gentianoides	"Variegata"	A mat-forming evergreen perennial with rosettes of dark green leaves, variegated white. Upright stems of

			blue flowers. Height 45cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun. Jun.-Jul.
<b>Veronica</b>	grandis		From the pointed sawtooth leaves come lengthening spires of deep royal blue flowers. Height 60-90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sep.
<b>Veronica</b>	kiusiana		A herbaceous perennial forming stems of toothed lanceolate leaves with terminal branched flowering stems of deep blue flowers. Height 75cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sep.
<b>Veronica</b>	longiflora	"Blauer Sommer"	An upright perennial with narrow mid-green leaves and large spikes of blue flowers. Height 90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Aug.-Sept.
<b>Veronica</b>	longifolia		An upright perennial with narrow mid-green leaves and spikes of deep blue flowers. Height 80cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Aug.-Sept.
<b>Veronica</b>	longifolia	"Blaubundel"	An upright perennial with narrow mid-green leaves and spikes of gentian-blue flowers with white stamens. Height 60cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Aug.
<b>Veronica</b>	longifolia	"Blauriesin"	An upright perennial with narrow mid-green leaves and spikes of bright blue flowers. Height 80cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Aug.-Sept.
<b>Veronica</b>	longifolia	"Schneeriesin"	An upright perennial with narrow mid-green leaves and spikes of pure white flowers. Height 90cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Aug.-Sept.
<b>Veronica</b>	oltensis		A creeping alpine with small scalloped deep green leaves and blue flowers with a white splash. Height 5cm. well-drained soil in sun. Apr.-Jun.
<b>Veronica</b>	peduncularis	"Georgia Blue"	A mat-forming evergreen perennial with glossy, purple-tinged leaves, bronze in winter, and deep blue flowers with a white eye. Height 20cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers almost

continuously.

<b>Veronica</b>	prostrata	"Mrs. Holt"	A dense, mat-forming alpine with narrow bright to mid-green leaves and short spikes of pale to mid-pink flowers. Height 15cm. Well-drained soil in sun. May-Jul.

<b>Veronica</b>	spicata	"Alba"	A mat-forming herbaceous perennial with toothed green leaves and erect spikes of white flowers. Height 35cm. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Jun.-Aug.

<b>Veronicastrum</b>	sibiricum		A tall erect perennial with whorls of dark green lanceolate leaves and graceful spikes of lavender-blue flowers. Height 2m. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Veronicastrum</b>	virginicum	"Album"	A tall erect perennial with light green narrow leaves and graceful spikes of white flowers. Height 1.75m. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Veronicastrum</b>	virginicum	"Erica"	A tall erect perennial with dark green narrow leaves and graceful spikes of pale pink flowers with darker stamens. Height 1.2m. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Veronicastrum</b>	virginicum	"Fascination"	A tall erect perennial with dark green narrow leaves and graceful spikes of bluish purple flowers. Height 2m. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Veronicastrum</b>	virginicum f. roseum	"Pink Glow"	A tall erect perennial with light green narrow leaves and graceful spikes of soft pink flowers. Height 1.75m. Moist soil in sun or part shade. Jul.-Sept.
<b>Viburnum</b>		"Shasta"	A wide-spreading shrub with ribbed green leaves, purple-red in autumn. Very large white flowers in tiers followed by red fruits ripening to black. Height 3m. Spread 4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May to June.
<b>Viburnum</b>	acerifolium		A small shrub with coarsely-toothed three-lobed maple-like leaves. The white flowers are borne in terminal clusters, followed by red fruits that turn purple-black. The leaves show

			good autumn colour. Height 2m. Spread 1.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun
<b>Viburnum</b>	atrocyaneum		An evergreen shrub of dense bushy habit with smallish glossy dark green leaves. White flowers in sparse terminal clusters. Small steely blue fruits in winter. Height 3m. Spread 2.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Viburnum</b>	carlesii	"Aurora"	A bushy deciduous shrub with dark green leaves turning red in autumn. Very fragrant pink flowers, opening from red buds followed by black fruit. Height 2m. Spread 2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from April to May.
<b>Viburnum</b>	carlesii	"Diana"	A bushy deciduous shrub with dark green leaves, bronze when young, turning red in autumn. Very fragrant purple-pink flowers fading to white, opening from red buds, followed by black fruit. Height 2m. Spread 2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade
<b>Viburnum</b>	cassinoides		A deciduous shrub with ovate, dull dark green leaves, bronze coloured when young. Small creamy-white flower are followed by rounded red fruits that change through blue to black. Good autumn colour. Height 2.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade
<b>Viburnum</b>	dauidii		A bushy shrub with veined, dark green leaves and clusters of tiny white flowers, followed by metallic-blue fruit in females. Both male and female plants needed to produce fruit. Height 1.5m. Spread 1.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Apr.-
<b>Viburnum</b>	dentatum		A deciduous, dense, upright shrub with glossy deep green foliage that turns purple in autumn. Flat creamy-white flowerheads are followed by blue-black berries. Height 3-4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from June to July.

<b>Viburnum</b>	erubescens var. gracilipes		An upright growing shrub with elliptic, glabrous leaves. Panicles of fragrant white, pink flushed flowers are followed by red berries that age to black. Height 3m. Spread 2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from June to July.
<b>Viburnum</b>	farreri		An erect shrub with dark green leaves, bronze when young, turning purple-red in autumn. Fragrant white flowers open from pink buds, on bare stems. Height 3m. Spread 2.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. November to February.
<b>Viburnum</b>	farreri	"Candidissimum"	An erect shrub with dark green leaves, pale green when young, turning purple-red in autumn. Fragrant pure white flowers on bare stems in late autumn. Height 3m. Spread 2.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from November to December.
<b>Viburnum</b>	farreri	"Nanum"	A dense, shrub with dark green leaves, bronze when young, turning purple-red in autumn. Fragrant white flowers open from pink buds, on bare stems in late autumn. Height 75cm. Spread 1m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from November to
<b>Viburnum</b>	odoratissimum var. awabaki		An evergreen shrub with obovate, glossy, green leaves and panicles of fragrant white flowers, followed by, in a good year, by red fruit that turns black with age. Height and spread 4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from May to June
<b>Viburnum</b>	opulus	"Compactum"	A very dense deciduous shrub with dark green leaves turning purple-red in autumn. Small white flowers, followed by fleshy bright red fruit. Height 1.5m. Flowers from May-Jun. Fertile well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Viburnum</b>	opulus	"Nanum"	A rounded shrub with dark green leaves, tinted dark red. Rich autumn colour. Flowers seldom produced. Height 80cm. Spread 80cm. Moist

			well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Viburnum</b>	opulus	"Park Harvest"	A deciduous shrub with rich gold jagged-edged leaves and white lacecap flowers. Height and spread 2.5m. moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. flowers from May to June.
<b>Viburnum</b>	opulus	"Roseum"	A rounded shrub with dark green leaves, purple tinted in autumn. Globular heads of creamy white flowers. Height 4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May to June.
<b>Viburnum</b>	opulus	"Xanthocarpum"	A bushy shrub with dark green leaves turning red in autumn. Flat heads of small white flowers from May to June, followed by fleshy bright yellow fruit. Height 5m. Fertile well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Cascade"	A bushy deciduous shrub with tiered branches. Dark green leaves turn purple-red in autumn. White lacecap flowers are followed by small red berries. Height 2.5m. Spread 3m. Any moist fertile soil in sun or part shade. flowers from May to June.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Dart's Red Robin"	A bushy deciduous shrub with tiered branches. Dark green leaves turn purple-red in autumn. White lacecap flowers in late spring followed by abundant red berries Height 2m. Any moist fertile soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Elizabeth Bullivant"	A form with small leaves and flat heads of pure white flowers. Small red berries in late summer. Good autumn colour. Height 1.5m. Spread 2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from April to May.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Grandiflorum"	Very free flowering deciduous shrub with large pretty saucer-shaped white flowers. Good autumn colour. Height 2m. Spread 2.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers April, May.

<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Lanarth"	A bushy deciduous shrub with deeply veined, dark green leaves, purple-red in autumn. Lacecap heads of white flowers. Height 3m. Spread 4m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from May to June.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Mariesii"	A bushy deciduous shrub with tiered branches. Dark green leaves turn purple-red in autumn. White flowers in late spring. Height 3m. Spread 4m. Any moist fertile soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Nanum Semperflorens"	A compact deciduous shrub with deeply veined, dark green leaves, purple-red in autumn. White flowers from late spring to autumn. Height 2m. Spread 1.5m. Fertile moist soil in sun or part shade. May-Sep.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Pink Beauty"	A bushy deciduous shrub with deeply veined, dark green leaves, purple-red in autumn. Pretty white flowers mature to pink in late spring. Height 3m. Spread 4m. Fertile, moist soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Popcorn"	A compact deciduous shrub with neat green pleated leaves and white flowers in a rounded ball. Height 2m. Spread 2m. Fertile moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from April to May.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Rotundifolium"	A bushy deciduous shrub with deeply veined, rounded dark green leaves, purple-red in autumn. Pretty rounded heads of white flowers. Height 3m. Spread 4m. Fertile, moist soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Rowallane"	A bushy deciduous shrub with deeply veined, dark green leaves, purple-red in autumn. Lacecap heads of white flowers. Height and spread 2.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from May to June.
<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"Summer Snowflake"	A bushy deciduous shrub with tiered branches. Dark green leaves turn purple-red in autumn. White lacecap flowers in late spring. Height 2.5m. Spread 3m. Any moist fertile soil in sun or part shade.

<b>Viburnum</b>	plicatum	"White Beauty"	A small leaved cultivar of this bushy deciduous shrub with tiered branches of dark green leaves that turn purple-red in autumn. White lacecap flowers produced along the stems. Height 2.5m. Spread 3m. Any moist fertile soil in sun or part shade. Flowers fr
<b>Viburnum</b>	sargentii	"Onondaga"	An upright deciduous shrub with coppery young growth ageing to dark green and turning purple-red in autumn. Pink flushed white flowers open from plum-red buds. Height 3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. May to June.
<b>Viburnum</b>	tinus	"Eve Price"	A compact shrub with dark green leaves. Clusters of white flowers open from carmine-pink buds, from late winter to spring, followed by dark blue-black fruit. Height 3m. Spread 3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Viburnum</b>	tinus	"Gwenllian"	A compact shrub with dark green leaves. Clusters of pink-flushed, white flowers open from dark pink buds, from late winter to spring, followed by dark blue-black fruit. Height 3m. Spread 3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade.
<b>Viburnum</b>	trilobum	"Bailey's Compact"	A vigorous yet compact deciduous shrub with lobed leaves and white flowers followed by red fruits. Height and spread 2.5m. Well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from May to June.
<b>Viburnum</b>	x bodnantense	"Charles Lamont"	An upright deciduous shrub with dark green leaves, bronze when young and fragrant, tubular white flowers, pink on the outside, on bare stems. Height 3m. Spread 2m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Nov.-April.
<b>Viburnum</b>	x bodnantense	"Dawn"	An upright shrub with dark green leaves, bronze when young. Fragrant, tubular rose tinted dark pink flowers, on bare stems. Height 3m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Nov.-Apr.

<b>Viburnum</b>	x burkwoodii	"Anne Russell"	A compact, rounded shrub with glossy, dark green leaves. Clusters of fragrant, white flowers from pink buds, followed by red fruit, ripening to black in autumn. Height 2m. Spread 1.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. April to May.
<b>Viburnum</b>	x burkwoodii	"Compactum"	A shorter version of this semi-evergreen rounded shrub with glossy, dark green leaves and clusters of fragrant, white flowers. Height and spread 1.5m. Moist well-drained soil in sun or part shade. Flowers from April to May.
